# **BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE WORKSHOP**

#### Conventional Retreatment of the Root Canal Treated Tooth

Successful management of root canal failures demands an understanding of the causes of failure and knowledge of the variety of retreatment techniques available including the recognition of the advantages and disadvantages of the various techniques. This lecture will outline the common causes of root canal failures and suggest some conventional as well as unconventional" endodontic retreatment techniques for root canals.

#### Single Vs Multi-Visits Endodontics- A Clinical Perspective

Single-visit endodontics is not a new concept in a clinical practice. However, clinicians are still confused to decide as to which root canal treatment option is better in between single or multi-visits endodontics. This presentation will highlight the guidelines and criteria for single-visit endodontics and emphasize the evidence based practice for single-visit endodontic therapy to achieve predictably successful outcome.

#### Endodontics or Implants?

The preservation of the natural dentition has always been the foundation for clinical decision making in Dentistry. Implant dentistry offers patients and practitioners to preserve and restore compromised teeth before extraction and replacement. This lecture will outline the fundamentals of success in Endodontics and compare available data between Endodontic and Implant Success. It will also attempt to outline some of the considerations and guidelines necessary when making and proposing the preservation of teeth as opposed to their replacement with implants.

#### **Effective Disinfection in Endodontics**

The ultimate goal of endodontic treatment is to completely eradicate bacteria, their byproducts and pulpal remnants. Optimal irrigation is based on the combined use of two or several irrigating solutions to obtain the goals of safe and effective irrigation. Many of the irrigants have been chemically modified and several mechanical devices have been developed to achieve optimal irrigation. The lecture will highlight various facts about disinfection and protocol which should be followed during endodontic therapy.

#### Preparing the Root Canal – the 'Next' Generation"

This workshop will provide participants with intensive hands-on experience on canal preparation using the "Protaper 'Next' Nickel Titanium rotary instruments with M Wire technology. Participants will be given an insight into the technological advantages as well as to be made aware of the precautions necessary to avoid complications when using these instruments. All participants are required to bring along an extracted molar (or premolar) with prepared access cavity and patent-canal with gentle curvature.
